Terms & Conditions:

1. **Student eligibility:** The competition is open to any student, from any discipline of any university or similar tertiary institution in Australia, excluding current employees or those that have been employees of Canon Information Systems Research Australia Pty Ltd (CiSRA) in the twelve months preceding the time of submission of the entry form. The project may be a group project and can have any duration, provided that the students are suitably enrolled.

Supervisor eligibility: Students must have at least one supervisor. The supervisor must be a member of the academic staff of the same university or similar tertiary institution as the students. If there is more than one supervisor, then at least one must be from the same institution as the student.

2. The description of the research:

(a) must consist of a report on the project of up to 10 pages in length (standard readable font, such as Times New Roman, Arial, Courier etc, font size of 12, line spacing 1.5, margins 2cm all around); and

(b) (optional) supporting material such as images, video or visualisation, which will be presented via a linked website.

The deadline for the project report is **5pm AEST, 1 November 2011**.
However, this entry form must be completed, signed and submitted by **5pm AEST, 10 October 2011**.

Terms & Conditions (Continued):

- 3. All material submitted must:
 - (a) be suitable for public disclosure and be non-confidential in nature;
 - (b) not breach the privacy of other people; and
 - (c) be original to the student/s and the supervisor/s ("the entrants") and must not infringe the intellectual property rights (e.g. copyright) and/or moral rights of other people.
- 4. The work in the project must have been done by the student/s named above, except where otherwise acknowledged (for example: your project might relate to image analysis techniques and could use images owned someone else in which case you would need to acknowledge and obtain permission from that person to use the images; your project might include making a device which required specialised machining, routine testing and characterisation techniques, or use of external equipment which needs to be calibrated that someone else might need to perform). All work must be undertaken within the ethical guidelines of the participating university or other tertiary institution.
- 5. First prize is \$5,000 for the student, and \$5,000 for the supervisor. If the winning entry is from a group of students, then the prize will be divided equally amongst the students. Similarly, if there is more than one supervisor, the prize will be divided equally amongst the supervisors. A runner-up prize of **one** (1) Canon 5D Mark II camera will be awarded to the second place winner. Similarly, if the second place winner is a group of students, then the consolation prize will be awarded to the group of students as a whole. CiSRA may award additional consolation prizes in their absolute discretion. Likewise, CiSRA may decide not to award any of the prizes based on the merit of the entries. Please refer to the website for the judging criteria.
- 6. Participants in this competition will cooperate with Canon Inc, Canon Australia and CiSRA in possible publicity/promotions associated with the competition and the awarding of the prize.
- 7. By entering into the competition, the student/s and the supervisor/s ("the entrants") grant to Canon Inc, Canon Australia and CiSRA a perpetual, irrevocable licence to use, reproduce, modify and publish the submitted materials for the purpose of the competition, including marketing and promotional purposes. The entrants waive the requirement to attribute/acknowledge them as the author of the submitted materials where it is inappropriate or impractical to do so. The entrants waive this and any other moral rights that they may have under any law of any country. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in these terms is to be construed as transferring ownership of any intellectual property rights from one party to another.
- 8. The entrants represent and warrant that they have read and will comply with the conditions of this competition. Furthermore, the entrants indemnify Canon Inc, Canon Australia and CiSRA for any failure to comply with these conditions. The entrants will perform all such acts and do all such things necessary to give effect to these conditions.
